

Five Year State and National Summaries of Dispute Resolution Data
Originally Prepared by CADRE December 2010
*(with "Cautions for Those Who Would Interpret
 State Dispute Resolution Data Reports")*
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This document summarizes the third through seventh years (2004-05 through 2008-09) of national dispute resolution data collection that began with the Part B Annual Performance Reports (APRs) submitted March 2004. The data for the first year (2002-03) are not provided here as they are of limited value for state-to-state comparisons. It is normal for a new data reporting requirement to take several years for data quality to stabilize and that has been the case with these data. For the second year (2003-04), the reported complaints timeline data are suspect; it is impossible to tell whether states submitted data that matches the definitions of “completed within timelines” and “completed within extended timelines.” Thus, these data also are not reported here.

This Summary of Part B Dispute Resolution Data (2004-05 through 2008-09) contains 40 one page summaries. States/entities submitted these data as Table 7 (Part B) of their Annual Performance Reports for 2004-05 and 2005-06, and, more recently, as Section 618 reports submitted by each state 2006-07, 2007-08 and 2008-09 data. Each page in the summary contains data from fifty-seven (57) states/entities, either the numbers of state-reported events or the rates (events per 10,000 in state child count) for each year in each of four dispute resolution reporting areas (Table 7 form and Instructions are available at: www.ideadata.org/docs/dispresPtB-2009.doc). The required data in Table 7 address:

- * Section A: written state complaints,
- * Section B: mediations,
- * Section C: due process complaints (and resolution meetings), and
- * Section D: expedited due process complaints.

Nationally, the filing of written state complaints peaked in 2004-05 (6,201) and has declined by almost 20% since then (see Table 1). Complaint reports issued and the proportion of complaint reports with findings have similarly decreased over the same period (22% and 20%, respectively).

The number of mediations reported (see Table 2) peaked in 2004-05 (7,121), then declined sharply in 2005-06 as the resolution process was implemented. Most of that decrease in mediation activity was in mediations related to due process; it appears that the resolution process was not only an additional dispute resolution option, but also initially replaced what would have been mediations held related to due process complaints. In the last three years, however, the number of mediations held and agreements reached have increased again to 6,054 mediations in 2008-09, with 4,246

agreements. From 2004-05 to 2005-06 due process related mediation as a percentage of all mediation activity dropped precipitously for both mediations held (from 60% to 35%) and for mediation agreements (from 58% to 27%), but these have increased again in the last three years. This shift may reflect an increased interest in using third party neutrals to assist parents and schools to resolve due process complaints, particularly where strained relationships may benefit from external support.

* California did not report on mediations for 2005-06. As a result, total national activity. Since California held an average of about 1,400 mediations for the past three years, this number might be estimated at 5,500 and other numbers might also be comparably higher for that year.

Due process (DP) complaint filings peaked in 2004-05, rising to over 21,000 filings (see Table 3). Since then, due process filings have declined by about 15% to just over 18,000 in 2008-09. The reported number of fully adjudicated due process hearings also peaked in 2004-05 and has declined sharply (by about 60%) over the last five years. The percentage of DP complaints that result in a hearing has declined substantially (from 35% to 16%, much of this the result of one entity’s reduction in activity) while the percentage of pending DP complaints has increased over the same period from 11% of requests to 14% of requests (the peak in pending hearings in 2007-08 nationally can be attributed largely to two states). The increase in pending complaints is likely due to the effective increase in the timeline when the resolution process runs its full 30 days.

The percentage of due process complaints resolved without a hearing has grown with the implementation of the resolution process (from 54% of filings in 2004-05 to 69% in 2008-09),

although only one sixth of these resolutions are reported as the result of a Written Settlement Agreement. A few states have offered summaries in their APRs for a breakdown of these “resolved without a hearing” numbers, but no comparable national data exists.

The data elements displayed in the 40 tables included in this document have been referenced to those used for the most recent report (2008-09). Although differences have been present across these five years in *data labels and what is reported* versus *what can be calculated based on reported numbers*, the definitions and data elements have the same meanings as those used for the most recent Table 7 form (2008-09). For a comparison of the Table 7 data elements across years, see Data Element Crosswalk 2004-05 thru 2008-09 (download at: <http://www.directionservice.org/cadre/statecomprpts.cfm>).

For each table of reported numbers (e.g., p. 4, “State Numbers Reported In Annual Performance Report, Written, Signed State Complaints, 2007-08”) there is a companion table showing the rate of dispute resolution events per 10,000 special education students (e.g., p. 9, “Rates Per 10,000 Special Education Students Enrolled, Written, Signed State Complaints, 2007-08”). These “Mean Reported State Rates” are calculated by dividing the number of dispute events by the childcount for that state for that year times 10,000. Alabama, for example, reported 78 written complaints filed in 2007-08 with a childcount of 84,772, yielding a rate per 10,000 of 9.2 per (78 divided by 84,772 times 10,000). These rates allow comparisons across states for any dispute resolution data element. The “Rate” tables include two “averages” at the bottom of each table:

- Mean of State/Entity Rates: this is the average of state reported rates (the sum of all 57 state rates per 10,000 childcount divided by the number of states reporting) – this is sort of a “Senate” view of activity, where each state’s contribution is equally weighted, regardless of population, and
- National Mean Rate: this is the average rate for the nation, for all reported dispute resolution activity (the total number of events divided by the total national childcount times 10,000).

Sometimes, the differences between these two measures of “central tendency” can be instructive. States with very high or very low rates disproportionately affect the Mean of State/Entity Rates regardless of their childcount. The National Mean Rate is not a rate typical of any state, per se, but does reflect national trends in dispute resolution use overall. In some cases, these two averages can differ substantially (e.g., see p. 29, Due Process Complaints Filed). Where the Mean of State Rate is substantially larger than the National Mean Rate, it is usually because one or a few states have very high rates of use compared to other states. Where the National Mean Rate is closer to the Mean State Rate there is something closer to a normal distribution of use rates across states.

CADRE has made every attempt to ensure that these data accurately represent what states reported to OSEP or have corrected through a verification process with CADRE and through error checking by and in collaboration with Westat’s Data Accountability Center for the 2006-07, 2007-08 and 2008-09 data. State Experiences with Dispute Resolution: "Cautions for Those Who Would Interpret State Dispute Resolution Data Reports"

There is wide variability in the rates of dispute resolution activity across states. For example, in Part B submissions:

- The “National Mean Rate” of state written complaint filings for 2008-09 (see page 10) is 7.6 per 10,000 special education child count, while the “Mean of State/Entity Rates” is slightly higher at 9.1 per 10,000. Both these averages, however, can mask variability; note that individual state rates varied in 2008-09 from less than one complaint filing per 10K, to over 90 per 10K.
- The State reported rate of mediations held in 2008-09 (see p. 20) ranged from none in three states/entities to more than 50 mediations held per 10K in three other states/entities.
- The State reported rate of hearings held in 2008-09 (see p. 30) among states reporting at least one hearing ranges from as low as .1 per 10K (or, one in 100,000 enrolled) to more than 10 hearings held per 10K students enrolled in five states/entities. One entity held more than 800 hearings per 10K, but this represented a 73% *decrease* from past rates of hearings held for that entity.

It seems unlikely that these variations result solely from real differences in educational programs across these states/entities. While use of dispute resolution options may reflect some educational program differences, other factors (e.g., differences in culture, history, dispute resolution systems, advocate and/or school approaches to conflict) are more likely the source of large differences in the use of dispute resolution options.

Another likely difference relates to the availability of alternate dispute resolution options. States differ in the level of support they provide for early and alternate dispute resolution processes. Some states have invested heavily in early dispute resolution and dispute prevention efforts and report far less formal dispute resolution activity than others.

Limitations of the Data:

The five years of data included in these tables were collected over a period during which the reporting requirements changed. In 2004-05, with the passage of IDEA 2004, new statutory State Performance Plan requirements were put in place and new data elements added: to Section C, Resolution Meetings (held in response to due process complaints), Written Settlement Agreements; and a new Section D, Expedited Due Process Complaints. Only four years of data on Resolution Meeting and Written Settlement Agreement data have been collected since the reporting requirement for resolution meetings was not fully in effect until July 1, 2005.

In response to adjustments in data reporting, CADRE worked closely with OSEP and the Data Accountability Center to provide states with information that would increase the likely comparability of data across years (e.g., error checking software, comparisons of data definitions and reporting form elements, methods of calculating some values not reported, etc.). The tables for all years use the 2008-09 data labels which are essentially the same as the data reporting categories that have been used for the past three years and that match the data definitions for all years.

What these reports do not provide is a complete view of what happens with dispute filings each year. Only dispute resolution activity initiated during the reporting year (July 1 through June 30) is included. Thus, pending hearings, due process complaints that were not completed, mediation

requests that did not result in a mediation held before the reporting period ended, mediations or hearings held that were initiated in a prior year, etc., are lost in this data reporting process. The number and status of “Written State Complaints *60 days after the end of the reporting period*” (August 29) are included but due process or mediation activities occurring after the end of the reporting period (June 30) are not reported. Since many states report anecdotally that they receive a disproportionate number of dispute filings/requests in the final quarter of the school year, the data may fail to reflect the outcomes of these late filings, especially for mediation and due process complaints.

Changes in policy (e.g., the addition as of July 1, 2005, of the resolution process and the specification of the contents of a written settlement agreement) are also likely to have affected how schools and parents resolve disputes. With such limited data and only five years of more or less comparable collection, it is difficult to say exactly what that impact may be, but it does seem safe to conclude that:

- The use of more adversarial dispute resolution process in general has decreased somewhat over this five year period,
- Resolution meetings displaced, at least initially, the use of mediations related to due process,
- Resolution meetings and mediations taken together have increased the number of reported instances where school personnel and parents at least meet with a focus on the collaborative resolution of conflict, and
- The percentage of pending hearings has increased somewhat as the timeline for due process complaints increased with the implementation of the resolution process (which can add up to 30 days to the overall due process complaint timeline).

State variance in meeting reporting requirements:

In addition to the shifting landscape for reporting and policy, the level of activity some states had from year to year varied quite substantially. Data systems have also been in transition in many states, so the method of data collection has not necessarily been consistent over the five years in all states. Some states have data systems that were not designed to collect all the required elements and are not easily changed (e.g., dispute resolution systems, for example, are operated by offices other than the Department of Education in many states). In some of these cases, the data collection processes of those agencies have been slow to accommodate the data reporting requirements of the SPP/APR. It is not clear how these differences have impacted data collection. Regardless of these limitations, the states have become more stable in their reporting practices and the data provide, for now, the best comparable view we have of dispute resolution activity across states.

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NOTE: On each page showing Rate Per 10,000 Child Count, two summary calculations are provided: “Mean of State/Entity Rates” is the average of the rates reported by states (sum of the state rates divided by the number of states); “National Mean Rate” is the average rate for all dispute resolution activity nationally (the number of events nationally divided by the total national child count). Either figure can be subject to extreme numbers in a single state.
